VOTE BY MAIL

As in prior elections, the Township of Wainfleet 2026 Municipal Elections will be conducted by Mail-In Ballots. As a result, there will be no Advance Polls or Proxy Voting. Voter Kits will be mailed to all eligible electors as contained on the Voters' List starting on Thursday, September 24, 2026.

In order to ensure that ballots are returned in time to be counted on Voting Day, electors are asked to please place completed Voter Kits in the return mail by Thursday, October 15, 2026. Alternatively, completed Voter Kits may be personally delivered directly to the Township Offices anytime the offices are open (8:30 am – 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday) or in the after-hours mail drop box. On Voting Day (Monday, October 26, 2026) only, ballots may also be returned to the Moore Room in the Wainfleet Arena, 31917 Park Street, from 10:00 am until the close of voting at 8:00 pm.

If you are eligible to vote and have not received a Voters' Kit in the mail by Wednesday, October 7, 2026, please contact the Clerk's Department or visit the Township Offices to confirm that you are on the Voters' List.

VOTERS' LIST REVISIONS

Are you on the list? Visit the Township of Wainfleet website www.wainfleet.ca/elections to ensure that you are on the Voters' List and that your information is correct. Applications to be added to the Voters' List (or to correct your information already on the list) will also be available at the Township of Wainfleet Municipal Offices, 31940 Highway 3, Wainfleet, starting on Tuesday, August 25 2026 (during regular office hours) – or visit our website at www.wainfleet.ca for more information (including to apply for corrections to the Voters' List online after Tuesday, August 25 2026).

IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED

If you are attending the Township Offices to correct your voter information or obtain a Voters' Kit, the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, requires all voters to present appropriate identification. Electors should bring at least two pieces of prescribed identification that shows your name and qualifying address. Acceptable identification includes: an Ontario Driver's Licence, Photo Health Card, Motor Vehicle Permit, Canadian Passport, Certificate of Citizenship, Property Tax Assessment Notice or Utility Bill.
